
## **FINISH STRONG**

## DO YOU KNOW WHEN YOUR FINAL EXAMS ARE?

You should know your final exam dates because it helps you plan study schedules effectively, manage your time efficiently, seek assistance in advance if needed, and approach exams with confidence and preparedness. College has a language of its own.. HERE'S A FEW COMMON TERMS!

#### ACADEMIC FORGIVENESS

An undergraduate student may request forgiveness for up to 9 credits of undergraduate semester hours at Mississippi State University in which they got a D, or F. Certain rules apply. Speak to your advisor if you want to forgive a class. See AOP 12.20

#### TRANSFER ARTICULATION

A student may be **approved to take courses at another institution.** The student should check to see if the course will transfer to MSU using the Registrar's <u>transfer articulation tool</u> and should always meet with an advisor before taking transfer courses to confirm that the courses completed will count toward an MSU degree.

#### TRANSIENT STUDENT

A transient or "guest student" is a student enrolled at another university, but taking classes at MSU that will count towards their degree at their home university. Enrollment is only on a temporary basis (such as a summer session) and is typically limited to one term.

#### **GPA CALCULATOR**

GPA calculator is used to help you **calculate your GPA** and can be used as a great tool for staying on top of your semester!
