GPA CALCULATOR

GPA calculator is used to help you **calculate your GPA** and can be used as a great tool for staying on top of your semester!

ACADEMIC PROBATION

Probation A student whose cumulative MSU GPA is less than 2.00 at the end of any term will enter the next term on academic probation and will remain on probation until his or her cumulative MSU GPA reaches 2.00 or higher. The student will be notified of probationary status by the Office of the Registrar.

INCOMPLETE

Under extraordinary circumstances and only at the discretion of the instructor, a grade of I (Incomplete) may be assigned to a student whose work is satisfactory but who has not completed a portion of the course. If you receive an "I" for your final grade, reach out to your instructor for next steps and notify your advisor.

ACADEMIC STANDING

Students who maintain a satisfactory semester and a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 are in good academic standing.

TAKING A SUMMER CLASS?

Let your advisor know ASAP! Why? We want to make sure your class will count toward your degree program!

If you are taking a summer course at another college/university, an off-campus request form **must** be submitted.
