COLLEGE KNOWLEDGE

College has a language of its own ... **HERE'S A FEW COMMON TERMS!**

REGISTRATION

The act of signing up for classes and creating a class schedule for the next semester. Students are required to meet with their academic advisor prior to registering for courses.

MINI-TERM CLASS

Courses that last for only eight weeks of the semester, either from the beginning of the semester to the mid-term, or from mid-term until the end of the semester.

PROGRESS GRADES

A grade that indicates your current standing in a course at this point of the term. Progress grades can be found in your Banner account.

ACADEMIC STANDING

Students who maintain a satisfactory semester and a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 are in good academic standing. You may be required to earn a higher GPA if you have scholarships or grants.
